Significant Accomplishments

The Girls track team won its fourth consecutive Conference Track Championship.

The Girl's soccer team upset #1 ranked Spring Lake in the District semi-finals after losing to them twice in conference play. This preceded a come from behind win over Cedar Springs to win the District Championship.

The Trojan Volleyball team continued their winning ways, taking home Conference, GMAA, District, and Regional championships.

Some long standing track and field records were broken this year: Briana Pekel (400 m) Erin Folkmier (300 hurdles); the 1600 relay team (Jayna Stone, Anna Stone, Dominique Jenkins, and Briana Pekel); and the 3200 relay team (Jayna Stone, Rachel Folkmier, Mallory Vest, and Briana Pekel).

Spring Coaches Bob Dorman (softball) and Dave Hulings (soccer) were District Coaches of the Year.

Competitive Cheer Coach Courtney McRobert and Volleyball Coach Nicole Bayle were named Lakes 8 Coach of the Year in their respective sports.

The Boys Bowling team qualified for State Finals.

Fruitport hosted championships in GMAA Wrestling, MHSAA Districts in Boys Basketball, Boys Soccer, and Girls Soccer.

Several teams participated in voluntary service projects this past year. The football team continued their elementary reading program, the construction of wheelchair ramps, and assisting the Lions Club with Old Fashioned Days activities. They also hosted football's first "pink out", raising over \$4,000, which was donated as a benefit to a family in need in their battle with cancer. The Boys Basketball and Boys Soccer teams joined forces with No More Sidelines and ran activities and clinics for special needs athletes. The Girls Basketball teams raised funds and awareness in the fight against cancer by contributing to local and national needs.
