- All AP Exams will be held in the high school wrestling room. Exceptions to this will be communicated by Mrs. Higgs directly to the students affected. The dates and times of the exams are listed below.
 - May 6 at 8am is AP Government
 - May 6 at noon is AP Chemistry
 - May 8 at 8am is AP English Literature
 - May 9 at noon is AP Psychology
 - May 13 at 8am is AP Calculus AB/BC
 - May 14 at 8am is AP English Language
 - May 14 at noon is AP Physics

Important Information for AP Test Takers:

- 1. Students should arrive 10 minutes early to allow for locating the testing rooms, using the restroom before test administration, etc. Students who arrive after the door has closed to the testing room will not be permitted to enter the testing room and will not test. There is not a makeup date offered for students who miss the test due to tardiness. No refund will be given to students who miss the test.
- 2. For 8:00am exams, there is no need to check into your 1st hour class; your attendance will be school-related for the testing window.
- 3. For "A lunch" students <u>who have an 8am exam</u> and the exam time goes beyond A lunch, please take B lunch on that specific exam day. For "B lunch" students <u>who have a noon exam</u>, please take A lunch on your exam day. For students who have an 8am and a noon exam on the same day, a communication will go out to the cafeteria letting them know when the exam has ended so they are prepared for you even if it is between lunches
- 4. Students should bring (2) sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers, two pens with black or dark blue ink only, and for those taking the AP Calculus, AP Chemistry or AP Physics exam, up to (2) approved calculators. Do not bring any other items with you as they will not be permitted in the testing room.
- 5. No electronic devices of any kind will be allowed in the testing room so leave your cellphones, smartwatches, computers (unless using them for the AP Literature or AP Lang digital exams) etc at home, in your car or in your locker.
- 6. Students who would like to have a snack or water during approved break times are encouraged to bring their own as these will not be provided by the school. These items will be left outside of the testing room until break time.
- Summer school applications are now available in the office. The cost is \$50 Forms and payment are due no later than Friday, May 13. Summer school will run 8:40 11:00 a.m. daily from June 10 June 28. Students will only be allowed one absence and will be dropped from the program after more than one absence. Classes are taken at Fruitport High School daily.
