#### Reconfirmation Meeting for February

**Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:**

Elementary students will remain full time. Effective March 1, 2021, secondary students will leave the hybrid schedule and return to full time. Those students in the virtual program will remain in that program through the end of the semester.

\*\*At semester, 127 students came back to face to face and 53 new students requested the fully virtual program. There are now approximately 366 students in grades K - 12 in the fully virtual program.
